

Update on the Agency's approach to sustainable development in policy making and its advice on fish consumption.

Executive Summary

- At its meeting in March, SFAC considered the Agency's public consultation into its review of its advice on fish consumption. The review had been initiated to ensure that the Agency's advice on fish consumption had fully considered sustainable development issues.
- During the discussions Committee members raised the wider question of the Agency's general policy consideration of sustainability matters, and expressed a view that the Agency should clearly define what it meant by sustainability.
- Members of the Committee are invited to receive a presentation from Bill Adamson, Head of FSA Scotland Strategic Policy and Consumer Engagement, updating them on the Agency's general approach to sustainable development in policy making and outlining the outcome of the specific consultation on its advice on fish consumption.

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
