

**CONSULTATION ON THE NATURAL MINERAL WATER, SPRING WATER AND BOTTLED WATER (SCOTLAND)
(AMENDMENT) 2010**

**SUMMARY REPORT OF RESPONSES TO CONSULTATION
FROM STAKEHOLDERS**

The consultation Natural Mineral Water, Spring Water and Bottled Drinking Water (Scotland) was issued on 30 November 2009 and closed on 25 January 2010.

This consultation gave stakeholders the opportunity to comment on the Scottish Statutory Instrument (S.S.I) putting in place enforcement powers for the European Commission Regulation on the use of activated alumina to remove fluoride from natural mineral waters and spring waters. The S.S.I. also reproduced some of the sampling and monitoring requirements contained within Council Directive 98/83/EC on the quality of water intended for human consumption.

The FSA in Scotland did not receive any responses to the above consultation.
