

# Wine De-acidification Notification

For Official Use

## Notes for Guidance

- Under the Wine Regulations it is a statutory requirement that the Wine Standards Branch is notified of the de-acidification of wine.
- When **wine** is de-acidified (but **not** grape must, whether or not in fermentation), producers are required to complete this form and return it to their local Wine Standards Branch inspector. The form must reach the inspector, at the latest, by the second day after the first operation has taken place. Any subsequent operations in that wine production year (1 August - 31 July) need not be notified. All operations must be entered in winery records.
- Wine may only be de-acidified by up to a maximum of 1g/l. There are no restrictions on the de-acidification of must.
- Complete the form in BLOCK LETTERS.
