

The Feeding Stuffs (Sampling and Analysis) and the Feeding Stuffs (Enforcement) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2003

General

The regulations principally transpose Directive 2002/70/EC on methods of sampling and analysis for dioxins and dioxin-like PCBs into national legislation.

Regulation 3

This regulation principally amends a number of the existing definitions in Regulation 1 of the Feeding Stuffs (Sampling and Analysis) Regulations 1999.

Regulation 4

This regulation amends Regulation 3 of the Feeding Stuffs (Sampling and Analysis) Regulations 1999, chiefly by inserting a reference to feed materials to be sampled under Directive 2002/70/EC.

Regulation 5

This regulation amends paragraph 1 of Regulation 6 of the Feeding Stuffs (Sampling and Analysis) Regulations 1999, principally by inserting references to the analysis of feed materials for dioxins and dioxin-like PCBs under Directive 2002/70/EC. The opportunity has also been taken to redraft existing provisions relating to the analysis of vitamins A and E.

Regulation 6

This Regulation amends Part IV of the Agriculture Act 1970 to require laboratories other than the agricultural analyst to undertake testing for dioxins.

Regulation 7

This regulation adds a reference to Directive 2002/70/EC to the Community legislation listed in Annex I of Part of Schedule 2 to the Feeding Stuffs (Sampling and Analysis) Regulations 1999.

Regulation 8

This regulation makes consequential amendments to the Feeding Stuffs (Enforcement) Regulations 1999, chiefly by amending the references therein to Sections 77(4) and 78(6) of the Agriculture Act 1970 to include reference to the analysis of feed materials for dioxins and dioxin-like PCBs under Directive 2002/70/EC. The opportunity has also been taken to redraft existing references relating to the analysis of vitamins A and E.
