REPEALING REGULATION (EC) NO 601/2008 ON PROTECTIVE MEASURES APPLYING TO CERTAIN FISHERY PRODUCTS IMPORTED FROM GABON AND INTENDED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION

I am writing to advise that the Commission published Regulation (EU) No 1114/2011 on 5 November 2011 which repeals Regulation (EC) No 601/2008. Please use the following link to the Decision <http://eur-lex.europa.eu/LexUriServ/LexUriServ.do?uri=OJ:L:2011:288:0023:0023:EN:PDF>

The additional controls on fishery products from Gabon under Regulation 601/2008 no longer apply from 8th November 2011.
