

MEAT HYGIENE SERVICE PERFORMANCE AGAINST AIMS/TARGETS: 2005/06

Issue

1. Monitoring of MHS performance against the aims/targets set by the MHS Board for 2005/06.

Background

2. The MHS Board agreed new aims/targets for 2005/06 intersessionally in June 2005 (Annex A). The aims/targets were reported to the FSA Board by the Chair of the MHS Board at the FSA Board meeting on 14 July 2005.
3. The attached report by the MHS (Annex B) is grouped by the five high level aims that were agreed, and provides information for the indicators identified against each aim. Due to the short period of time since finalisation and agreement of the aims/targets, it has not been possible to report progress fully against every indicator or provide a textual analysis for every aim. Areas currently under development are identified at various points throughout the report. Work is in progress to report fully against all indicators and to improve the presentation of all indicators, before the next progress report to the MHS Board.
