THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 28 January 2002 laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety¹, and in particular Article 18(5) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Article 18 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 establishes the general principles of traceability of food.
- (2) Traceability is indispensable to ensure food safety and the reliability of information provided to consumers. In particular, it is necessary to apply traceability to frozen foodstuffs of animal origin and foodstuffs of animal origin intended for freezing to assist in enabling unsafe food to be removed from the market, thereby providing for the protection of consumers.
- (3) In addition, it is necessary to inform food businesses throughout the food chain of the durability of the food handled and stored under general or specific conditions.
- (4) Experience of the application of Regulations (EC) No 178/2002, (EC) No 852/2004, (EC) No 853/2004 and (EC) No 854/2004 has revealed that operators do not regularly have available the information necessary to ensure the adequacy of their systems concerning the identity of the foods they are handling or storing.
- (5) It is appropriate to specify certain rules for the specific sector of food of animal origin for the purpose of applying the requirements of Article 18 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002.
- (6) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the [...] Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Information required for traceability purposes in respect of food of animal origin

Food business operators shall ensure that the following information accompanies consignments of food of animal origin and is made available to the competent authority upon request:

- (a) An accurate description of the foodstuff,
- (b) The quantity of the foodstuff,
- (c) The premises of production,
- (d) The premises of dispatch if different,
- (e) The premises to which the product is being sent,
- (f) The name of the consignor, or owner, if different
- (g) The name of the consignee,
- (h) The batch or lot number,
- (i) The date of dispatch
- (j) The date of freezing, if applicable.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the [...] day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
