

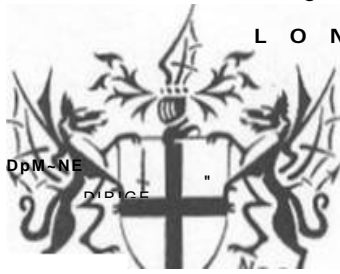

Airway bill	Commercial documents providing a general description of air cargo items
ANIMO	The computer system designed to enable one Member State to send a message to another confirming that a consignment is/will be on its way, which may require further checks at destination.
BIP	EU Border Inspection Post situated at a seaport or airport or international rail or road link
CAA	Civil Aviation Authority
CAP	Common Agricultural Policy
CCA	Central Competent Authority
CA	Competent Authority
CEFAS	Centre for Environment, Fisheries and Aquaculture Science
Consignment	Consignments can consist of one type of product, or a number of different types of products, which is covered by the same health certificate and/or airway bill or bill of lading. See legal definition in POAO Regs.
CoP	Code of Practice issued under the Food Safety Act 1990, the Food Hygiene (England) Regulations 2006 and the Official Feed and Food Controls (England) Regulations 2007.
