Tesco are recalling a specific date code of Tesco Red Cabbage & Apple 300G, due to the incorrect Use By date code of 29 DEC printed on packs, instead of 11 DEC.

Risk statement

An extension of the Use by Date could pose a risk to health, if the product is kept past the correct shelf life of the product.

Action taken by the company

Tesco is recalling the above product. The company have issued a recall notice to their customers. This notice explains to customers why the product is being recalled and tells them what to do if they have bought the product. Please see attached notice.

About product recalls and withdrawals

The FSA issues Product Withdrawal Information Notices and Product Recall Information Notices to let consumers and local authorities know about problems associated with food. In some cases, a 'Food Alert for Action' is issued. This provides local authorities with details of specific action to

be taken on behalf of consumers.
