Marks & Spencer is recalling M&S Sticky BBQ Wings and Chinese Style Wings because they contain soya which is not mentioned on the label. This means these products are a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy to soya.

## Action taken by the company

Marks & Spencer is recalling the above products from customers and has contacted relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall. The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the products are being recalled and tells them what to do if they have bought the products. ## **Our advice to consumers**

If you have bought the above products and have an allergy to soya, do not eat them. Instead return them to the store from where they were bought for a full refund.

### **About allergy alerts**

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
