

# Crunchy Bakery recalls Bulka Tarta (breadcrumbs) because of undeclared soya

Crunchy Bakery is recalling Bulka Tarta (breadcrumbs) because it contains soya which is not mentioned on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy to soya.

## Risk statement

**Allergen(s):** Soya

This product contains soya making it a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy to soya

## Action taken by the company

Crunchy Bakery is recalling the above product from customers and has been advised to contact the relevant allergy support organisations, which will tell their members about the recall.

## Our advice to consumers

If you have bought the above product and have an allergy to soya, do not eat it. Instead return it to the store from where it was bought for a full refund.

## About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold. Then it might be 'withdrawn' (taken off the shelves) or 'recalled' (when customers are asked to return the product). Sometimes foods have to be withdrawn or recalled if there is a risk to consumers because the allergy labelling is missing or incorrect or if there is any other food allergy risk. When there is a food allergy risk, the FSA will issue an Allergy Alert.
