BFree Foods is recalling BFree Sunflower & Pumpkin Seed Loaf because it may contain peanuts which are not mentioned on the label. This means the product is a possible health risk for anyone with an allergy to peanuts.

The company has also issued a point-of-sale notice to its customers. These notices explain to customers why the product is being recalled and tell them what to do if they have bought the product. ## About allergy alerts

Sometimes there will be a problem with a food product that means it should not be sold.
